The Exhibitor shall be bound to comply with the regulations issued by the Local Exhibition Organizer. No Exhibitor may obstruct or fill open passages and open spaces, just as there must be no construction above the height of the booth without special permission from the organizer. The Exhibitor is responsible to observe the fixed limits of the construction.

Stand reservation

The chronological order receipt of "Exhibition Application Form" and the following payment of rental fees establish the booth allocation priority. Special wishes will be taken into account as far as possible. The Lead Organizer shall be entitled to change allocation of booths and exhibition area, if there is a high demand for extra exhibition space.

Terms of payment

For invoicing practice the Local Exhibition Organizer is commissioned by the Lead Organizer. Invoice to be paid 14 days from receipt of invoice.

Transfer of space

Exhibitors are not permitted to lend their exhibition space to a third party, either in part or in whole without agreement with the Lead Organizer. The use of the stand area by an additional enterprise (co-exhibitor) requires special registration by the exhibitor and approval by the Lead Organizer.

Exhibits

Exhibitor must inform the Local Exhibition Organizer about equipment with high power consumption at the time of signing the agreement. Extra power consumption and installation costs will be a subject of an additional flat-rate charge or, with prior agreement; the actual costs incurred will be invoiced separately.

Damage to Facilities

No part of any exhibition materials, including posters, can be attached to columns or walls or any parts of the Exhibition Venue. Any damage to the Venue by an exhibitor shall be the financial responsibility of the exhibitor.

Security

A guard will be supplied by the Lead Organizers from evening of 27th to the morning of 30th of September 2009 during the hours when the exhibition is not open. The Lead Organizers are not responsible nor do they guarantee the Exhibitor against loss of any kind. The safekeeping of the exhibitors' property is the responsibility of each exhibitor.

Sales and publicity

Placing or handling out of publicity material, samples, etc. outside the exhibition space is not permitted. Political propaganda is prohibited. The Exhibitor shall not promote companies, which have not been recognized in writing as an Exhibitor. Cash sales or on-site sales within the exhibition space are prohibited.

Copyrights and Proprietary Material

The Exhibitor shall obtain all necessary licenses and shall pay all costs and fees arising from the use of copyrighted materials, or any other property subject to any trademarks, patent or other proprietary rights, which is used or incorporated in the Exhibition.

Liability, insurance

The Exhibitor shall be liable in full for all damages caused by the exhibitor or agents acting on their behalf to the exhibition stand and its installation as well as to third parties.

The Lead Organizer is free from all liability without fault regarding initial shortcomings of the rented object. The Lead Organizer accepts liability without limit for all willful damages and gross negligence regarding key contractual obligations. The Lead Organizer is free from liability for the exhibits, the personnel manning the stand(s) or visitors to the stand(s). It shall be the responsibility of the Exhibitors to obtain insurance against injury of person or theft, fire damage or loss of property in such amounts as the exhibitor shall deem adequate. Insurance will NOT be offered to the Exhibitor by the Lead Organizer.

Cancellation policy

The Lead Organizer must receive notification of cancellation of exhibition space in writing by 1st of June 2009. Cancellations after this date are not permitted. In case of cancellation before 1st June 2009 the incurred costs must be paid in full. The rental charges for the stand(s) are payable in full if the exhibitor withdraws from the contract without citing legally valid grounds for doing so, or otherwise fails to take part in the event.

If the Exhibitor fails to fulfill obligations, the Lead Organizer and Local Exhibition Organizer are entitled to annul the stand reservation. Unforeseen events which make it impossible to carry through the exhibition as planned shall entitle the Lead Organizer to cancel the exhibition.

Force majeure

In case of cancellation or suspension of the Exhibition due to force majeure, war, fire, earthquake, adverse weather, regulations of the authorities, strike, or other circumstances beyond the control of the Lead Organizer that might render it impossible or difficult to carry through the arrangement, the Lead Organizer shall be entitled to transfer, in whole or in part, the arrangement to other premises, to postpone the implementation of the arrangement to another time or to cancel the arrangement, and the Lead Organizer shall not be liable to pay compensation to the Exhibitor or be bound to reimburse the stand rental paid, neither be liable for any expenditure or liability or loss, including consequential loss incurred by the Exhibitor.

Claims

Any complaint shall be made forthwith and not later than at the closing of the exhibition and shall be sent in writing to the Lead Organizer.

The court of Berlin-Charlottenburg is responsible for legal disputes.
